

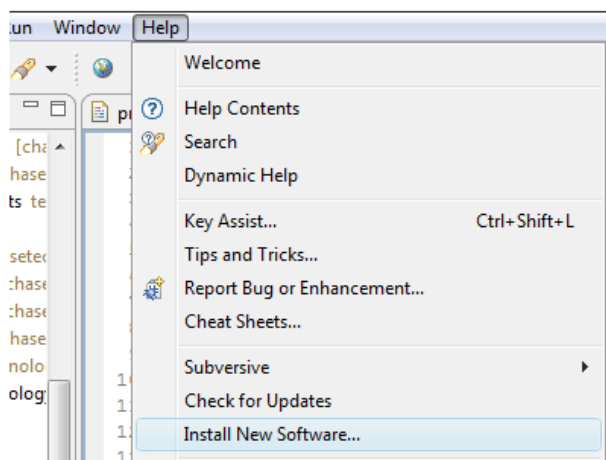
Perfection Installation Instructions

1. Install Eclipse

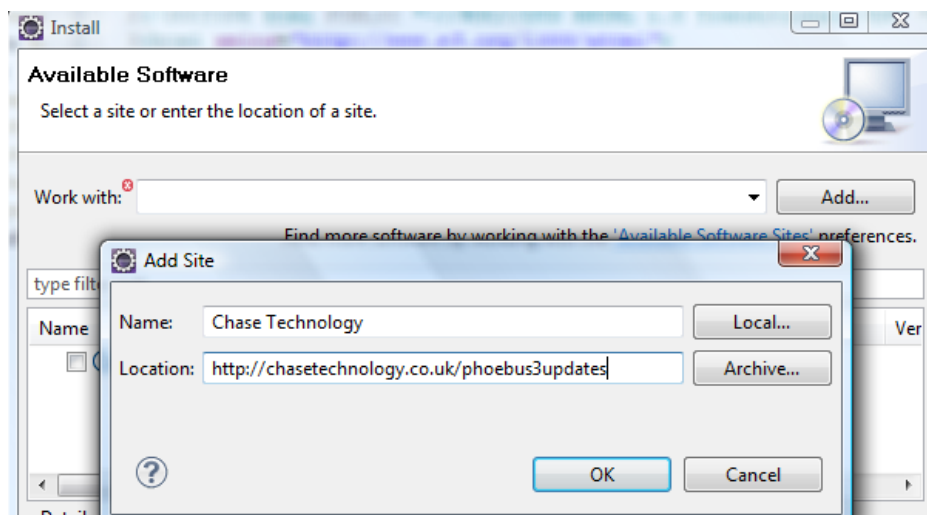
Some developers may already have Eclipse 3.3 or greater installed. If so, then you may skip this step. Visit <http://www.eclipse.org/downloads/> to download a version of Eclipse (the latest Eclipse IDE for Java EE Developers is recommended). Following the Eclipse installation instructions, simply unzip Eclipse into a convenient location on your hard drive.

2. Install Perfection

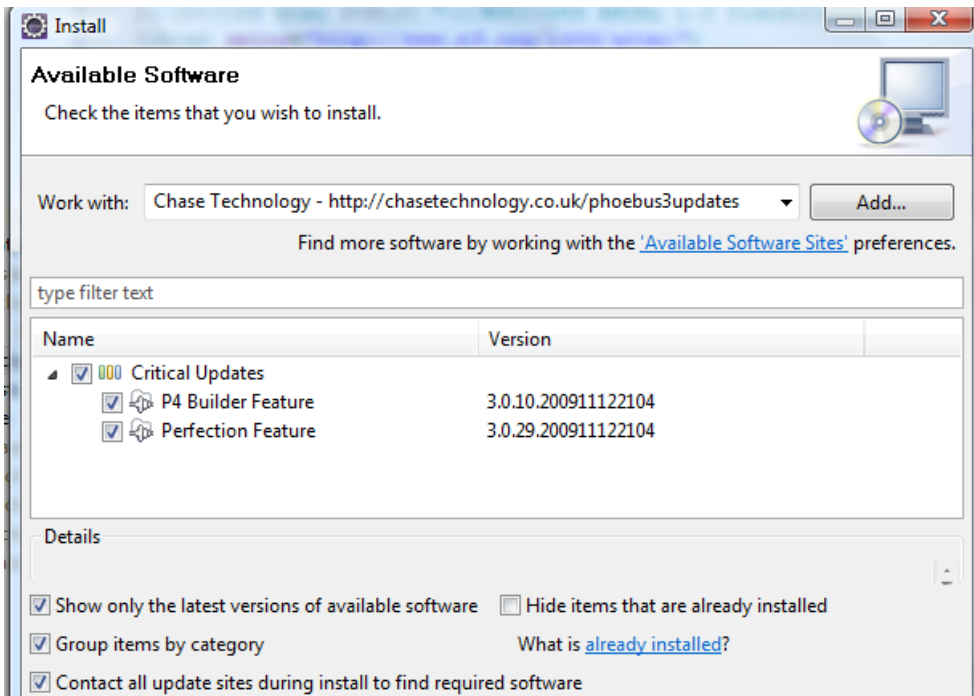
Open Eclipse, and then open the Help menu and select “Install New Software”:



In the dialog that opens click “Add” and then enter “Chase Technology” as the name and “<http://chasetechnology.co.uk/phoebus3updates>” for the Location:



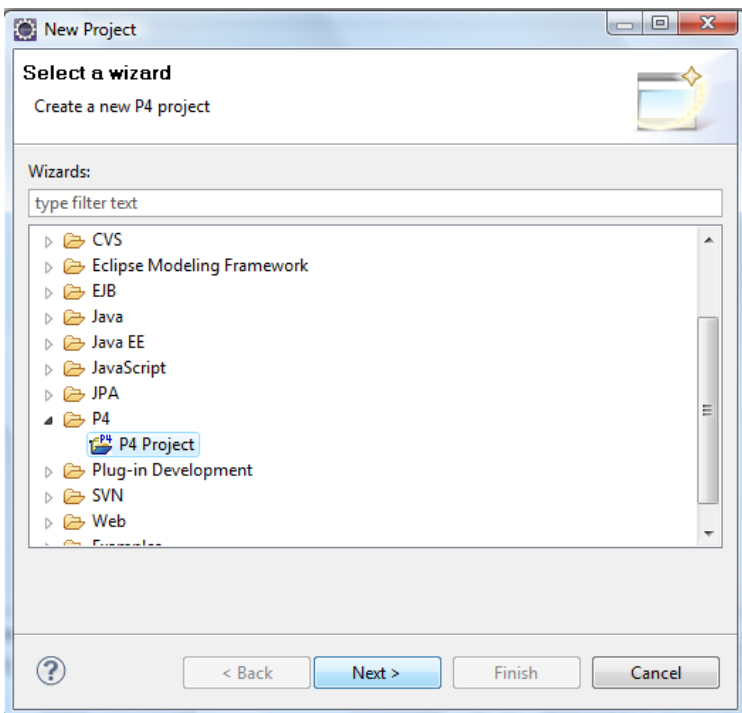
Then click OK and select the “Critical Updates” checkbox:



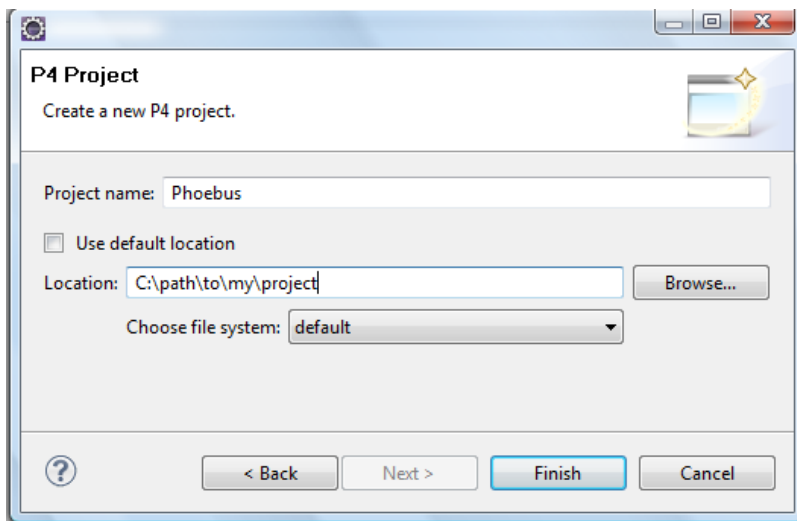
When the software has downloaded, opt to restart the application.

3. Create a P4 Project

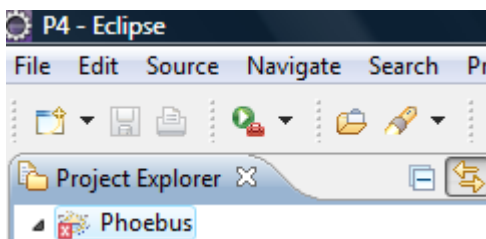
Switch to the P4 perspective, and select File -> New -> Project, and then choose "P4 Project".



In the resulting dialog, enter a name for the project. Uncheck "Use default location" and browse to the location of your Phoebus installation directory (this is the directory that contains the views, and the 'direct' and 'modules' folders).

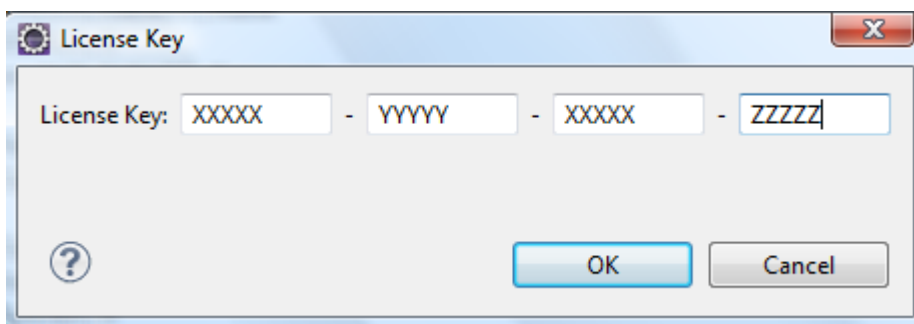


When created, the resulting project will have a logo of a sun overlaid on top of it:



4. Enter the License Key

Simply open a P4 file you will be prompted to enter a license key:



Your P4 project will now begin building. As this is the first time, the build will take a minute or two.
